

Start of Introduction to Cricket Coaching Course

The Belgian skies brightened up for 12 keen delegates attended the first day of a 2 day course on teaching cricket. The course is being held in conjunction with the British School of Brussels and saw recruits from the National Team, cricket clubs and those involved in junior cricket. The syllabus covers practical teaching methods and “how to coach skills” for batting, fielding and bowling and looks to the long term development of players. Sheel Shukla, who introduced the course and delivered the scoring practical exercise, commented that the course attempts to increase the quality of play and participation in the game, whether you are a player, official or keen parent.
